- Permission for the superfinal:** best 6 female and 9 male and equal scores.
Before the superfinal the groups will be updated according to the actual results.
The superfinal will be played on 1 round.
Sequence: female, male.
The result of the superfinal will be added to the results before.
- Necessary teams throw-off:** immediately after end of competition at the course played at the end.
- After competition:** medals ceremony for single competition at the courses.
- 8 pm** closing and presentation ceremony.
